




Draw a loop, then a line at the back. a for apple starts the alphabet pack...






b for banana, nice and yellow. His bed has a line and the curve is his pillow..




Make a curve like half the sun, just with that c for car is done...







In d for dino, a loop and line meet - at the end of the bed where you put your feet..




e for elephant curves up and goes around so now you, the letter e have found..






A hook going down with another line across makes for fish and fairy floss...




A loop with a tail now take a look. in q for quitar, the tail has a hook







Down from top to bottom you march, h for helicopter then draws an arch...




This one you could draw with a blindfold - a line with a dot, i for igloo is cold.






j for jellyfish has a hook on its tail, remember the dot and you cannot fail...




A line up to a loop, kick it out to the end, k for kite can be your friend...




Just a line makes for leaf.







o for octopus is just like naught. It's just a circle of a sort...






Down, up, down, up - w does flow, w for watch tells the time we all know...





A curve leaning that way another leaning this, x for xylophone like a cross you can't miss.
